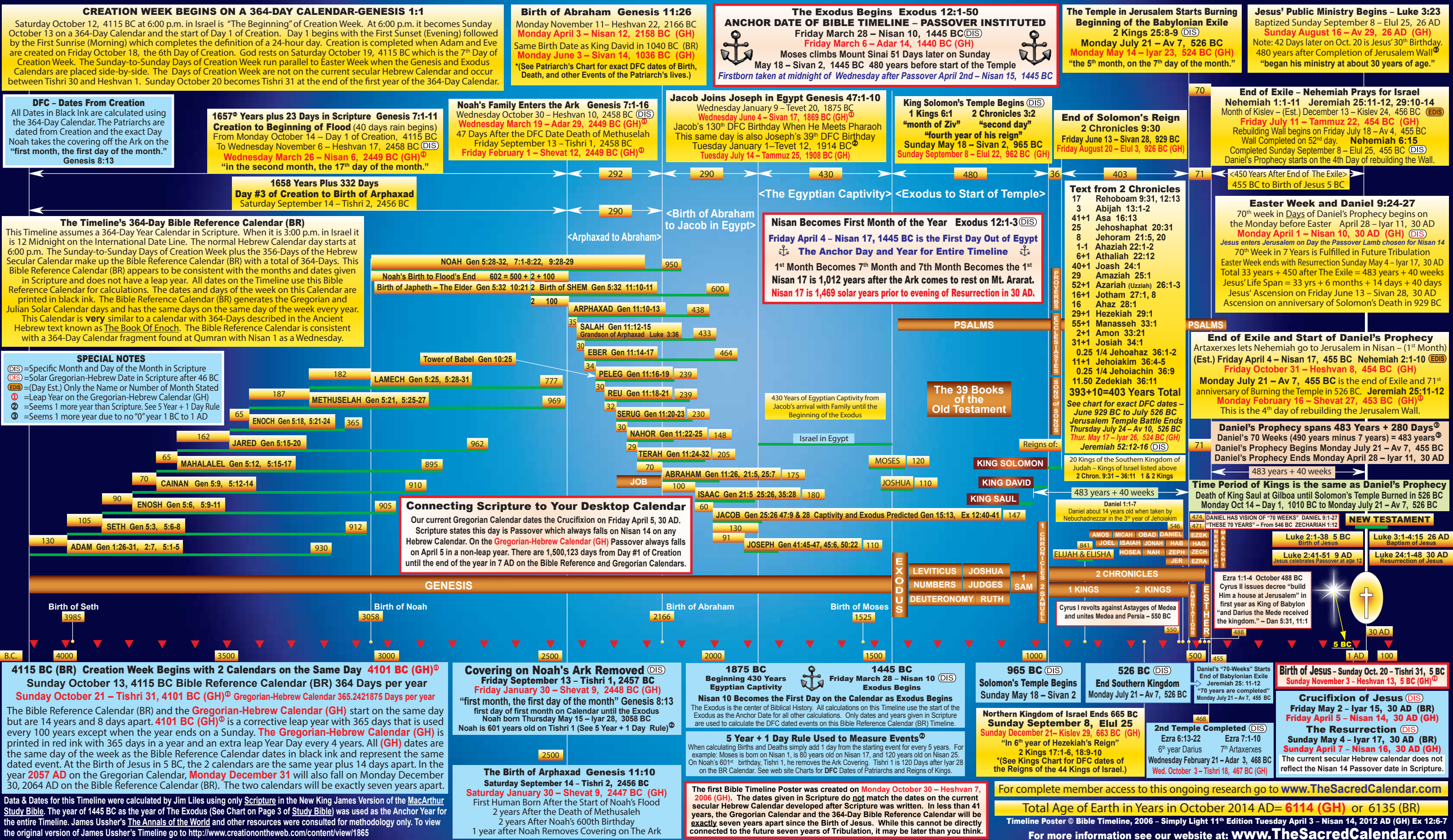


REAL HISTORY: THE TIMELINE OF THE BIBLE



CREATION WEEK BEGINS ON A 364-DAY CALENDAR-GENESIS 1:1
 Saturday October 12, 4115 BC at 6:00 p.m. in Israel is "The Beginning" of Creation Week. At 6:00 p.m. it becomes Sunday October 13 on a 364-Day Calendar and the start of Day 1 of Creation. Day 1 begins with the First Sunset (Evening) followed by the First Sunrise (Morning) which completes the definition of a 24-hour day. Creation is completed when Adam and Eve are created on Friday October 18, the 6th Day of Creation. God rests on Saturday October 19, 4115 BC which is the 7th Day of Creation Week. The Sunday-to-Sunday Days of Creation Week run parallel to Easter Week when the Genesis and Exodus Calendars are placed side-by-side. The Days of Creation Week are not on the current secular Hebrew Calendar and occur between Tishri 30 and Heshvan 1. Sunday October 20 becomes Tishri 31 at the end of the first year of the 364-Day Calendar.

 All Dates in Black Ink are calculated using the 364-Day Calendar. The Patriarchs are dated from Creation and the exact Day Noah takes the covering off the Ark on the "first month, the first day of the month."

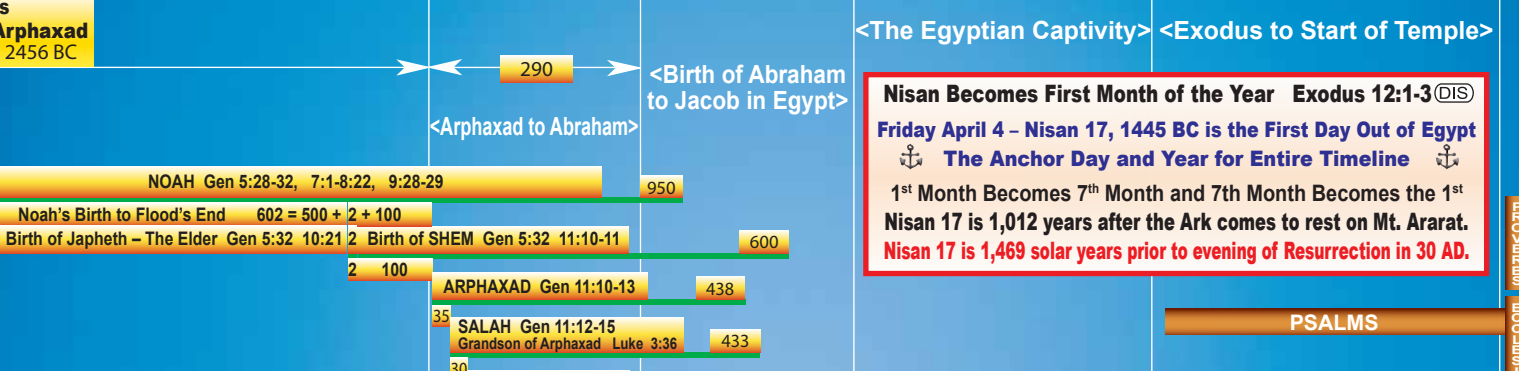

The Timeline's 364-Day Bible Reference Calendar (BR)
 This Timeline assumes a 364-Day Year Calendar in Scripture. When it is 3:00 p.m. in Israel it is 12 Midnight on the International Date Line. The normal Hebrew Calendar day starts at 6:00 p.m. The Sunday-to-Sunday Days of Creation Week plus the 356-Days of the Hebrew Secular Calendar make up the Bible Reference Calendar (BR) with a total of 364-Days. This Bible Reference Calendar (BR) appears to be consistent with the months and dates given in Scripture and does not have a leap year. All dates on the Timeline use this Bible Reference Calendar for calculations. The dates and days of the week on this Calendar are printed in black ink. The Bible Reference Calendar (BR) generates the Gregorian and Julian Solar Calendar days and has the same days on the same day of the week every year. This Calendar is very similar to a calendar with 364-Days described in the Ancient Hebrew text known as *The Book Of Enoch*. The Bible Reference Calendar is consistent with a 364-Day Calendar fragment found at Qumran with Nisan 1 as a Wednesday.

- (GH) = Leap Year on the Gregorian-Hebrew Calendar
- (*) = Seems 1 more year than Scripture. See 5 Year + 1 Day Rule
- (Q) = Seems 1 more year due to no "0" year 1 BC to 1 AD

Connecting Scripture to Your Desktop Calendar
 Our current Gregorian Calendar dates the Crucifixion on Friday April 5, 30 AD. Scripture states this day is Passover which always falls on Nisan 14 on any Hebrew Calendar. On the *Gregorian-Hebrew Calendar (GH)* Passover always falls on April 5 in a non-leap year. There are 1,500,123 days from Day #1 of Creation until the end of the year in 7 AD on the Bible Reference and Gregorian Calendars.



4115 BC (BR) Creation Week Begins with 2 Calendars on the Same Day 4101 BC (GH)
Sunday October 13, 4115 BC Bible Reference Calendar (BR) 364 Days per year
Sunday October 21 - Tishri 31, 4101 BC (GH) Gregorian-Hebrew Calendar 365.2421875 Days per year

The Bible Reference Calendar (BR) and the *Gregorian-Hebrew Calendar (GH)* start on the same day but are 14 years and 8 days apart. **4101 BC (GH)** is a corrective leap year with 365 days that is used every 100 years except when the year ends on a Sunday. The *Gregorian-Hebrew Calendar (GH)* is printed in red ink with 365 days in a year and an extra leap Year Day every 4 years. All (GH) dates are the same day of the week as the Bible Reference Calendar dates in black ink and represent the same dated event. At the Birth of Jesus in 5 BC, the 2 calendars are the same year plus 14 days apart. In the year **2057 AD** on the Gregorian Calendar, **Monday December 31** will also fall on Monday December 30, 2064 AD on the Bible Reference Calendar (BR). The two calendars will be exactly seven years apart.

 The Exodus is the center of Biblical History. All calculations on this Timeline use the start of the Exodus as the Anchor Date for all other calculations. Only dates and years given in Scripture are used to calculate the DFC dated events on this Bible Reference Calendar (BR) Timeline.

5 Year + 1 Day Rule Used to Measure Events
 When calculating Births and Deaths simply add 1 day from the starting event for every 5 years. For example: Moses is born on Nisan 1, is 80 years old on Nisan 17, and 120 years old on Nisan 25. On Noah's 601st birthday, Tishri 1, he removes the Ark Covering. Tishri 1 is 120 Days after Iyar 28 on the BR Calendar. See web site Charts for DFC Dates of Patriarchs and Reigns of Kings.
